## Calling all members

This year a new ISACA Curacao Chapter Board will be elected. The election takes place June 10, 2016 18:00 p.m. at the Central Bank during our Annual General Meeting.

### How long does a Board stay on?

A Board stays on for two years. After this period a Board member can stay on the Board, but needs to change position.

### What positions are available?

- President
- Vice-President
- Treasurer
- Secretary
- Membership Director/Certification & Training Coordinator

### What are the tasks of each position?

### How does the election take place?

Board members shall be elected by ballot. In the event there is only one candidate, voting on that Board member may be done by voice.

We will start by electing the President, then the Vice-President, the Treasurer, the Secretary and at last the Training Coordinator. Any member of the ISACA Curaçao Chapter can post for a Board member position. In case you are not elected for the first position you post for, do not be disappointed, and post for the next position. You have five changes for getting elected in the Board. Given the amount of members chances are big you will be elected.

### When do we have a quorum?

The quorum for any regular, annual general or special meeting shall be 10 members. In absence of quorum, the meeting will be adjourned, and reconvened in one week. The new date and time and pending decisions will be communicated to the members. In absence of quorum on the new date communicated pending decisions can be approved by a minimum of 5 members including 3 members of the Chapter Board.

### The Cyber Security Kill Chain

In our interconnected world cyber threats are escalating faster than global companies defense mechanisms can keep up with. ISACA has stepped up to solve this global problem and shape the cyber security profession by issuing a new security knowledge platform and professional program called the Cyber Security Nexus (CSX).

The ISACA Curacao Chapter acknowledges the need for knowledge in the cyber security landscape. This knowledge has to be transferred to managers, information specialists, auditors and risk managers.

The focus of this year for ISACA Curacao will be cyber security.

We will start this topic with a lunch session in the Marriot Hotel. A pre-recorded session 'The Cyber Security Kill Chain' will also be broadcasted, that will explain the steps hackers take to enter and exploit your network.

A panel of specialist will be available to answer your questions on the subject.

This event is sponsored with internal funding. The Board chose lunch time to accommodate as many members as possible. We encourage all our members to come to learn about this topic and getting to know your fellow members. Depending on the success we will continue with more lunch sessions this year.

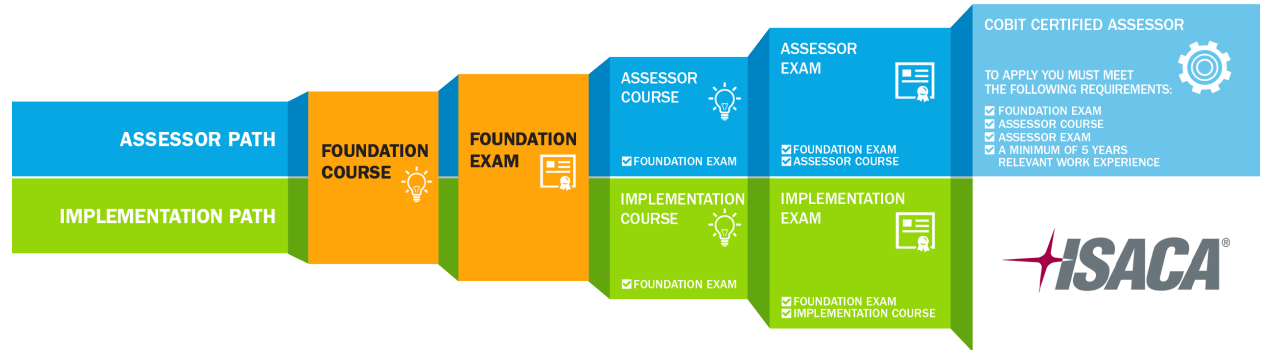
